Fam trip 1 – Stately Homes and Gardens:

To continue the tour, located in 1,000 acres of the most beautiful deer park, the former Egerton family home, Tatton Park, is open for you to explore. Following a light lunch, you will be free to wander through the mansion and gardens. The parkland has been home to herds of deer since 1290 and archaeological surveys show that Stone Age people hunted here and that there was farming activity in the Bronze Age. Before heading back, we will visit the famous Arley Hall where the Gardens, which are amongst the finest in Britain, are outstanding for their vitality, variety and historical interest and are particularly celebrated fo the magnificent double herbaceous border.

Fam trip 2 - Waterways and Heritage				
Depart Park Royal Hotel for Port Sunlight and Lady Lever Museum, which celebrates the unique heritage of the beautiful and historic industrial village of Port Sunlight - people, formal planning, architecture, and parks & gardens - from its foundation in 1888 for William Hesketh Lever's soap workers, to life in the villag today.				
After an exciting start, unlock the wonders of the region's waterways at National Waterways Museum, Ellesmere Port. With its delightful waterside setting, flotillas of historic boats and fascinating displays housed in fine Victorian buildings, the museum makes for a perfect day out. You will be able to enjoy a boat trip through an industrial landscape, visit the museum blacksmith and explore traditional narrow boats and homes through the ages, complete with cottage gardens, all before tucking into a light lunch. You are then invited for a tour of the Anderton Boat Museum where you will discover the reason behind why the boat lift earns its name as the "Cathedral of the Canals".				
To close the afternoon, you will visit Lion Salt Works and enjoy a history lesson on salt-making in Cheshire, which dates back over 2,000 years, when the salt towns of Cheshire were first established by the Romans.
